All - Receive his soul and present him to God the Most High.

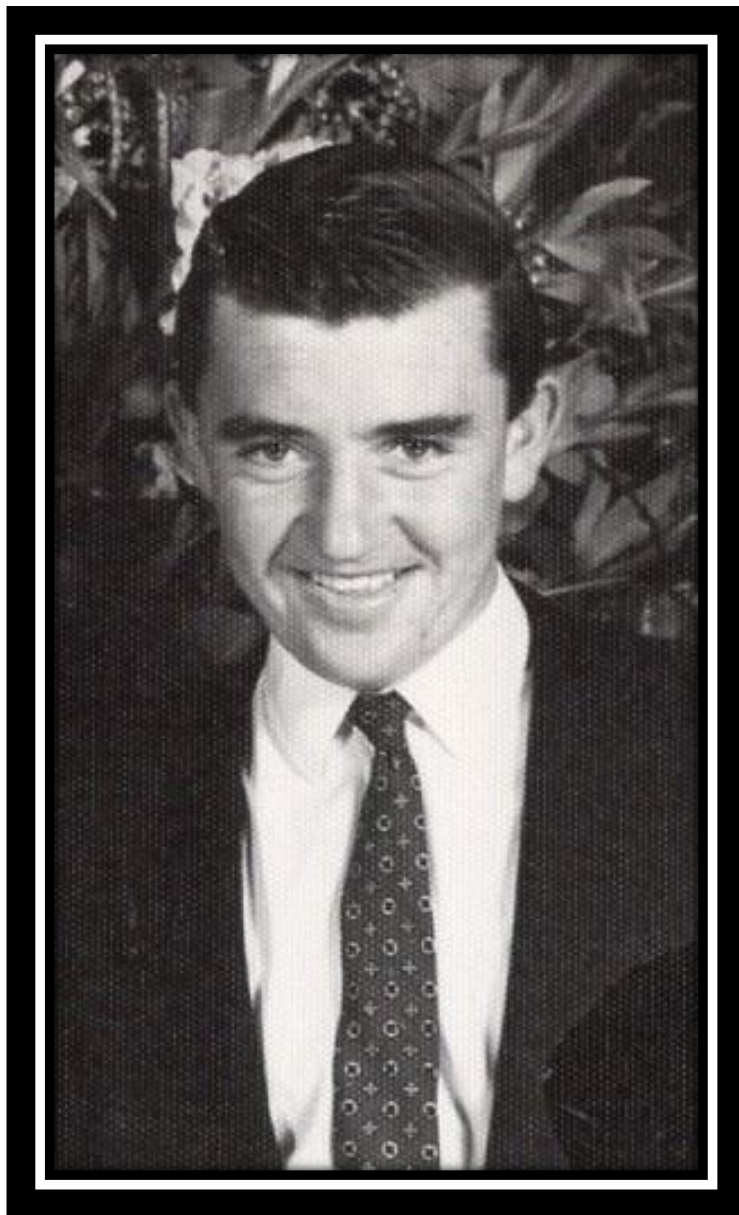
Fr Dean - Eternal rest grant unto him O Lord,
