and laughter through the years.

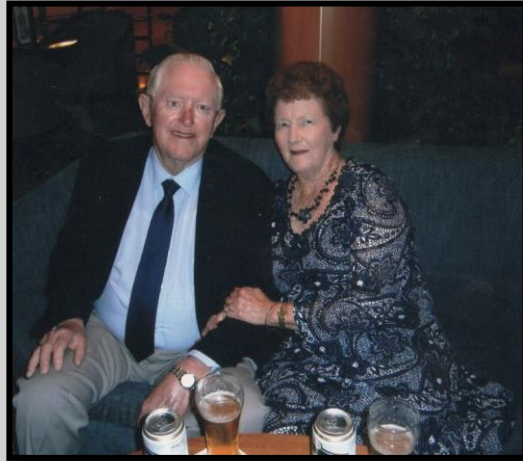
