Then they gathered around him and asked him,


“Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?”

They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. “Men of Galilee,” they said, “why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven.”

Eucharistic Prayer

Fr Nathan: The Lord be with you.

ALL: And with your spirit.

Fr Nathan: Lift up your hearts.

ALL: We lift them up to the Lord.

Fr Nathan: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

ALL: It is right and just.

Fr Nathan: It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God, through Christ our Lord. For he is the salvation of the world, the life of the human race, the resurrection of the dead.

Through him the host of Angels adores your majesty and rejoices in your presence for ever. May our voices, we pray, join with theirs in one chorus of exultant praise, as we acclaim:

Fr Nathan: Therefore, as we celebrate the memorial of his Death
and Resurrection, we offer you, Lord, the Bread of life and the
Chalice of salvation, giving thanks that you have held us worthy to be in
your presence and minister to you.

Humbly we pray that, partaking of the Body and Blood of Christ,
we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit. Remember,
Lord, your Church, spread throughout the world,
and bring her to the fullness of charity,
together with Francis our Pope, Shane our Bishop and all the clergy.
Remember your servant Angela, whom you have called today
from this world to yourself.

Grant that she who was united with your Son in a death
like his, may also be one with him in his Resurrection.

Remember also our brothers and sisters who have fallen asleep in the hope of the
resurrection, and all who have died in your mercy:
welcome them into the light of your face.

Have mercy on us all, we pray, that with the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God,
with blessed Joseph, her Spouse,
with the blessed Apostles, with St Patrick, our Patron,
and all the Saints who have pleased you throughout the ages,
we may merit to be coheirs to eternal life, and may praise
and glorify you through your Son, Jesus Christ.

Through him, and with him, and in him,
O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
all glory and honour is yours, for ever and ever.

The Communion Rite
